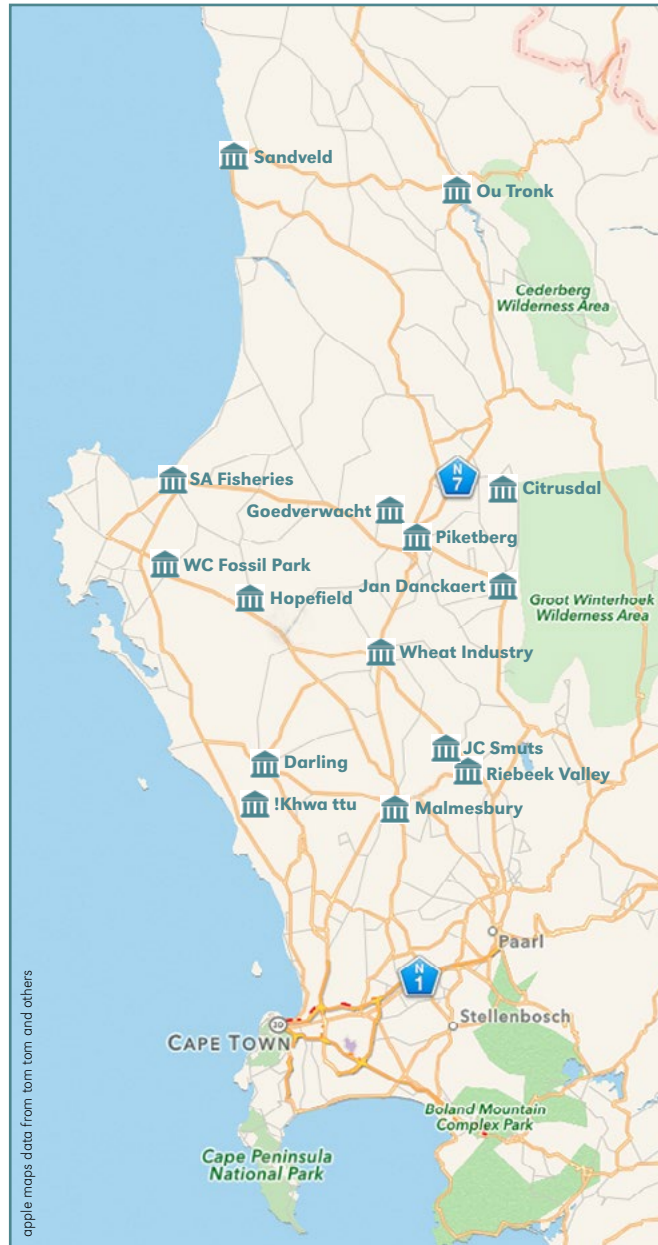

A unique museum in that it highlights the history of fishing on the West Coast from the whaling history to pelagic fishing and rock lobster catching.

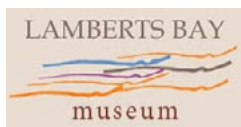
